Whereas there has been decreed in the General Land Office of the United States Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress Approved 20 of May, 1862 To Secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Samuel G. Buchanan has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the above numbered One thousand three hundred and four of section one in Township one North of Range four East and the west half of the south west quarter of section six in Township one North of Range five East, in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory containing one hundred and forty one acres and twenty five hundredths of an acre.

According to the official plats of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Samuel G. Buchanan the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Samuel G. Buchanan and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I have signed Grant, president of the United States of America have caused the letters to be made patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine and of the Independence of the United States the nine fourth By the President U.S. Grant.
