

"Twilight" claim. Bald Mountain Mining District

Know all men by these Presents, that I, the undersigned, have this 26th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the Lawton Lode along the South Easterly course thereof, 1500 feet of said claim, lying and being immediately North of, and adjacent to the Yellow Jacket Lode, with all dips, spurs, variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:

Situated on the East of the East Fork of the North Fork of the Wascoyal River, and to the North of the Yellow Jacket Lode, and adjacent to the North side line thereof, and parallel thereto - Commencing on the centre of said Fork, and running thence on a South Easterly direction 1500 feet, situated in the South half of Section 21 Township 3, North Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian.
