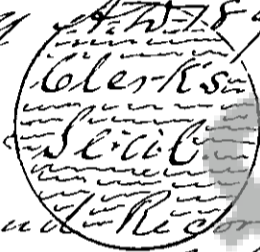

The United States of America, To whom these Presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain;" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William H. Enos has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law: for the North West quarter of Section Twenty-eight in Township Two North, of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory
