NOTICE OF LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that C. B. Spencer of Chenoweth, Skamania County Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings, and all the real and personal property of the owners above named, to-wit: E. S. Howe and Ben Sweet, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of H. S. Lumber Co, which franchise, earnings, real and personal property, was and is used in the operation of the saw-mill and business of the said owners, hereinafter described, to the full extent of all moneys due the said claimant from the said owners for labor performed within six months next preceeding the filing of this claim, as follows:

The demand which is made by the said C. B. Spencer is for the sum of \$115.00 after deducting all just credits and offsets. The name of the persons employing claimant were said E. S. Howe and Ben Sweet, at the terms and conditions of said employment were that claimant was to haul ties and lumber for said owners at the agreed price of \$3.50 per thousand feet. That pursuant to said agreement the said claimant commenced to perform said labor and services on or about the 19th day of September 1918 and completed said work and labor on the day of Dec. 2 1918, and that claimant so hauled 12000 M feet of said ties and lumber, and there is due and payable the claimant therefor the sum of \$115.00 no part of which ~~has~~ been paid excepting the sum of \$_____, leaving a balance now due claimant of \$115.00.

The property upon which this lien is filed and the franchises and earnings thereof, and the real and personal property of said owners upon which this lien is filed is situated in Skamania County Washington, and this claim is filed for security for the moneys due for the labor aforesaid, and the property affected hereby is the saw-mill of the said H S Lumber company situated at Willard Washington, the machinery, tools and appurtenances thereunto belonging and used in connection therewith, all lumber, ties and logs at the said mill, and at the S P & S railway right of way at Cocks, the said lumber, ties and timber at the said S P & S. Railway being piled to the west of the driveway to the Cocks Depot, and being about 1100 ties and 7 M 8 x 16 x 28 timber. Also all ties and lumber piled along the road from Willard to Cocks belonging to said H S Lumber company, and the above named owners.

And the said claimant claims a laborer's lien upon the said ties, lumber and timber, for the said sum of money now due for work, labor and services performed upon and about the cutting and manufacture and hauling the same within 30 days immediately preceeding the filing of this claim.
