

## COMBS TO DIAMOND L LUMBER CO.

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st day of May, 1918, at the request of Sam Sampson, president of the Diamond L Lumber Company a corporation, and who was acting as agent of said company, S. T. Combs commenced to perform labor upon the construction and operation of the saw mill belonging to the said Diamond L Lumber Company located about one and one half miles north of Dopp's Spur, in Skamania County, Washington, that said claimant agreed to work for the said corporation a part of the time so employed by the day, and a part of said time by the hour and the time and amounts so expended at labor and the amounts agreed to be paid claimant are as follows:

That the said labor ceased on the December 28th, 1918 and that the said labor at the agreed wage amounted to the sum of \$1402.64, on which amount nothing has been paid save and excepting the sum of \$983.00 leaving a balance due the claimant herein after deducting all just credits and offsets - the sum of \$419.64, for which amount claimant claims a lien on all franchised earnings, real and personal property, including the saw mill, flumes, timber, lumber, machinery and property of every kind and nature belonging to the said Diamond L Lumber Co.
