## NOTICE OF LIEN.

Notice is hereby given that Henry Snyder of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien on the franchise, earnings, and on all the real and personal property of Hans Berge, J. C. Prohaska and Hod Delano doing business under the firm name of Carson Lumber Company, a co-partnership, which is used in the operation of its business; the principal place of business of said co-partnership being at Carson, Washington, and their mill property and franchises being located in Wind River Valley at or near Bear Creek and Panther Creek, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered operating the plant of said co-partnership; That the names of the persons constituting the said co-partnership are, Hans Berge, J. C. Prohaska and Hod Delano doing business under the firm name and style of Carson Lumber Company.

That Claimant was employed by said co-partnership to perform such labor and assistance and said co-partnership agreed to pay claimant for such labor and assistance; that said contract was faithfully performed and complied with on the part of this claimant, who performed labor and assistance for said co-partnership for six months preceding 18th May 1919; that the rendition of said services was closed on 18, May 1919; that ninety days have not elapsed since the close of the rendition of services and that there is now due and owing to claimant for said services the sum of \$171.04 no part of which has been paid and that the whole of said sum is now due and unpaid after deducting all just credits and offsets.
