

"Boirne" Claim, Bald Mountain Mining District.

Know all men by these Presents, That I the undersigned, have this 24th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location, 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the Boirne Lode along the course or strike thereof 750 feet of said claim, lying and being on each side of the discovery shaft with all dips, spurs, variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:
