

Location Notice for the Lumber Claim

To Whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, That I, of Manning City, of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington and the local laws and rules and regulations of miners did on the Twenty-third day of May A.D. 1880 locate and by me notice do hereby create a Quartz Claim known as the St. James Gold or Mining Claim said claim having been discovered on the day of May 1880 and the claim is eight hundred linear feet on the lead side or side having mineral in place to six hundred feet in width the same being two hundred feet on each side of the center line, bearing with all directions and angles and all other terms or conditions the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries. Mining claim of mining ground situated in Copper River Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or prominent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit:

Beginning at the center of the corner of North and North East corner end of the Lumber Claim located by St. James. Thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction to the center of Charles Creek and North East corner of the Lumber Claim located by Margaret McHard. Thence 500 feet in an Easterly direction to the North East corner stake. Thence 1000 feet in a Northerly direction to the North East corner of the Lumber Claim. Thence 500 feet in a Westerly direction to the North West corner stake. Thence 1000 feet in a Westerly direction to the North West corner stake. Thence 500 feet in a Westerly direction to the center of the monument in place at North and North West corner of Charles Creek about 200 feet up the stream of Charles Creek where the East end of Condon Creek and Charles Creek come together.

The South west corner stake stands on the North Slope of Bald Mountain about 100 feet westerly from where the above named streams come together. The South end stakes of the Raymond Claims now become the South End stakes of the St Anthony Claim. The South end stakes of the Genevieve Claims becomes the North end stakes of St Anthony Claim. This Claim center line now runs diagonally across the claim known as the Bulger from North east corner of to Charles Creek & located by J. F. Manning

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
