Know all Men by these Presents, that I, the undersigned, have this 24th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location ¹⁵⁰⁰ linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the Hotnam Lode along the course or strike thereof, 700 feet of said claim, lying and being on each East and West side of the foot of said claim discovery shaft, with all dips, spurs, variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:

Situated on the North and South sides of Creek No. 1, and along the course thereof, (which Creek crosses the Lawton Trail South of the Skamania Mine Cabin, about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile South of said Cabin); and South, Westly of the Chimney Rocks, and parallel with the Easterly course of the Skamania and the Bourne Lodes, and lying between them.
