

"Chimney Rock" claim, Bald Mountain Mining District

Know all Men by these Presents, that I, the undersigned, have this 25th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the Chimney Rocks Lode along the South easterly course thereof, 1500 feet of said claim, lying and being next the Boronite claim East end line located by H.
