

"Limonite" Claim, Bald Mountain Mining District.

Know all Men by these Presents, that I, the undersigned, have this 25th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the Shell Rock Lode along the South Easterly course thereof, 1500 feet of said claim, lying and being next to the Malachite claim located by C. A. Czerstel, with all dips, spurs, variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:

Situated on the course of No. 1 Creek North of the Skamania Lode, and partly on the South side thereof, and North of the Chimney Rocks; Commencing at the East end line of the Malachite claim, and running thence in a South Easterly direction parallel with and adjacent to the North side line of the Chimney Rocks Lode - Situated in the North half of Section 28 of Township 3 North Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian.

The name of this claim is the Limonite; and it is in the Bald Mountain Mining District.
