

Frederick Zahl to Peder Martin Pederson.

Know all men by these presents that I, Frederick Zahl, (an unmarried man) of Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of one thousand dollars (\$1000) to me paid by Peder Martin Pederson, of the same County and State, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Peder Martin Pederson, his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, Being lots numbered three (3) and four (4) and the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Six (6) in Township Two (2) North of Range Five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, Containing one hundred and twenty-five acres and fifty one hundredths of an acre, more or less.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all my estate, right, title, ^{and} interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

To have and to hold the above described and granted premises, unto the said Peder Martin Pederson, his heirs and assigns forever. And I, Frederick Zahl, grantor above named do Covenant to and with Peder Martin Pederson the above named grantee, his heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
