L. DOUGLASS, AT THE SAID MILL, AND IN CONNECTION WITH THE SAID BUSINESS, IN HAULING LOGS, LUMBER AND OTHER TIMBER AND IN DOING LABOR IN THE MANUFACTURE OF LOGS, LUMBER AND OTHER TIMBER, AT, FOR AND IN CONNECTION WITH THE BUSINESS OF, SAID MILL; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNER OF SAID FRANCHISE, EARNINGS AND REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IS A. L. DOUGLASS, DOING BUSINESS UNDER THE NAME OF DOUGLASS LUMBER COMPANY; THAT SAID LABOR, WORK AND ASSISTANCE COMMENCED ON THE 26TH DAY OF DECEMBER 1919, AND THE LAST WORK AND LABOR PERFORMED WAS SO DONE AND PERFORMED ON THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL 1920; THAT CLAIMANT WAS EMPLOYED BY THE SAID A. L. DOUGLASS, AND SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WAS RENDERED AT THE REQUEST OF THE SAID A. L. DOUGLASS, UPON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

\$2.50 PER THOUSAND FEET FOR HAULING LUMBER

9.00 PER DAY FOR 8 HOURS WORK LOGGING.

1.00 PER HOUR BANKING LUMBER AND HAULING FROM BEACH.

THAT CLAIMANT'S WORK AND LABOR SO PERFORMED WAS OF THE REASONABLE VALUE OF \$209.64, AND THAT NO PART THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID EXCEPT THE SUM OF \$43.41, AND THERE IS NOW DUE AND OWING THE CLAIMANT THE SUM OF \$167.23, OVER AND ABOVE ALL JUST CREDITS AND OFF-SETS, FOR WHICH AMOUNT CLAIMANT CLAIMS A LIEN AS AFORESAID. THAT SAID SERVICES, LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WAS DONE AND PERFORMED WITHIN SIX MONTHS LAST PAST AND THAT NINETY DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THE COMPLETION THEREOF.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT LOUIE THUMB OF UNDERWOOD, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON CLAIMS A LIEN UPON A CARLOAD OF CORDWOOD, BEING ABOUT 25 CORDS IN QUANTITY, WHICH WAS CUT IN THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, AND STATE OF WASHINGTON WHICH IS UNMARKED AND WHICH IS NOW LYING IN A CAR ON THE SPOKANE, PORTLAND AND SEATTLE RAILWAY COMPANY'S YARD AT UNDERWOOD, WASHINGTON, FOR LABOR PERFORMED UPON SAID CORDWOOD IN HAULING THE SAME, THAT THE OWNERS OR REPUTED OWNERS ARE J. M. HARRIS, J. H. HARRIS, WM. HORNBY AND C. L. RUFF, THAT SAID OWNERS EMPLOYED CLAIMANT AND.... TO HAUL SAID CORDWOOD ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS TO-WIT AT THE RATE OF THREE AND SEVENTY-FIVE ONE HUNDREDTHS (\$3.75) PER CORD.

THAT SAID OWNERS AGREED TO PAY THE SAID CLAIMANT FOR SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE THE SAID SUM OF \$3.75 PER CORD, THAT SAID THAT SAID CONTRACT HAS BEEN CAREFULLY CARRIED OUT AND FULLY PERFORMED BY CLAIMANT WHO PERFORMED LABOR AND ASSISTED THEREIN IN HAULING SAID 25 CORDS OF WOOD FOR A PERIOD OF SEVERAL DAYS THAT SAID LABOR SO PERFORMED WAS BETWEEN THE FIRST AND TWENTIETH DAYS OF JULY, 1920 AND THE RENDITION OF SAID SERVICES WAS COMPLETED ON THE 19TH DAY OF JULY, 1920 AND THIRTY DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THE COMPLETION OF SAID SERVICES, THAT THE AMOUNT OF THE DEMAND OF CLAIMANT FOR SAID SERVICES IS THE SUM OF \$93.75, THAT NO PART THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID THAT THERE IS NOW DUE AND REMAINING UNPAID THEREON AFTER DEDUCTING ALL JUST OFFSETS AND CREDITS THE SUM OF \$93.75 IN WHICH AMOUNT HE CLAIMS A SAID CAR LOAD OF CORDWOOD. THE SAID CLAIMANT ALSO CLAIMS A LIEN ON ALL CORD WOOD NOW OWNED BY SAID OWNERS IN SAID COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, TO SECURE PAYMENT FOR THE SAID WORK AND LABOR PERFORMED IN OBTAINING AND HAULING SAID CORDWOOD HEREIN DESCRIBED.
