Is here by given that the undersigned a Citizens of the United States
Over the Age of twenty-one years on the 19th day of July 1887 discovered
A vein or Lode of Quartz and placer mines in place bearing
Gold Silver and Lead within the limits of the Claim hereby
located and have this 19th day of July 1887 under and in
accordance with the revised Statutes of the United States
located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or Lode
in length with surface down of three hundred feet in
width on each side of center of said Lode situated in the
Texas Gold Mining District - County of Maricopa and Territory
of Washington and known as the Gladsome Mining Claim
and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this point
at the discovery or prospect shaft. The exterior boundaries
of this Claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural
objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described
as follows. No. 1 Beginning at the prospect hole or shaft
running 15.00 feet to and from this point and monument No. 1
Thence 8.00 feet northerly to monument No. 2 Thence 15.00 ft to
monument No. 3 in a northeasterly course thence 800 ft to monument
No. 4 Thence 800 ft in a southerly direction to monument No. 5
Thence 15.00 ft to the south west corner and monument No. 6
Thence 800 ft to place of beginning and further more doth claim
the water power running through this Claim and that we
intend to hold and work said aforesaid claim as provided by the
Local Laws and the customs and rules of miners and mining
Statutes of the United States discovered on the ground thru
the 19th day of July 1887 located in Texas Mining District
