NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT NEVA BOLTON, OF THE DALLES, WASCO COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, CLAIMS A LIEN UPON A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF CORD WOOD, BEING ABOUT 300 CORDS, WHICH WERE CUT IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND WHICH TO THE KNOWLEDGE OF CLAIMANT, ARE WITHOUT ANY SPECIAL MARK, WHICH AMOUNT OF CORD WOOD IS NOW LYING IN AND UPON THAT CERTAIN FORTY ACRES OF LAND OWNED BY LANE & SEXTON AND DESCRIBED AS:

IN THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, STATE OF WASHINGTON, FOR LABOR PERFORMED AND ASSISTANCE RENDERED TO SAID C. G. FOSTER, IN THE BUSINESS OF CUTTING CORD WOOD IN AND UPON SAID LAND HEREINBEFORE DESCRIBED; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNER, OR REPUTED OWNER OF SAID CORD WOOD IS C. G. FOSTER; THAT SAID C. G. FOSTER EMPLOYED SAID NEVA BOLTON TO PERFORM SUCH LABOR AND RENDER SUCH ASSISTANCE, UPON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO-WIT:

THAT THE SAID C. G. FOSTER AGREED TO PAY THE SAID NEVA BOLTON FOR LABOR AND WORK AS COOK IN THE LOGGING CAMP OF SAID FOSTER, THE SUM OF SIXTY DOLLARS PER MONTH, FOR SUCH LABOR AND ASSISTANCE; THAT SAID CONTRACT HAS BEEN FAITHFULLY PERFORMED AND FULLY COMPLIED WITH ON THE PART OF SAID NEVA BOLTON, WHO PERFORMED LABOR UPON, AND ASSISTED IN THE WORK OF SAID LOGGING CAMP, BY ACTING AS COOK FOR THE LABORERS AND LOGGERS IN THE EMPLOYMENT OF SAID C. G. FOSTER, AND THAT SAID WORK AND ASSISTANCE WAS FOR THE PERIOD OF TWO MONTHS; THAT SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WERE SO PERFORMED AND RENDERED UPON SAID CONTRACT, AND FOR THE BENEFIT OF C. G. FOSTER, BETWEEN THE 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1920, AND THE 22ND DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1920; THAT THE RENDITION OF SAID SERVICE WAS CLOSED ON THE 22ND DAY OF NOVEMBER 1920, THIRTY DAYS NOT HAVING ELAPSED SINCE THAT TIME; THAT THE AMOUNT OF CLAIMANT'S DEMAND FOR SAID SERVICE IS ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS; THAT NO PART THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID, AND THERE IS NOW DUE AND REMAINING UNPAID THEREON, AFTER DEDUCTING ALL JUST CREDITS AND OFFSETS THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS, IN WHICH AMOUNT SHE CLAIMS A LIEN UPON SAID CORD WOOD. THE SAID NEVA BOLTON ALSO CLAIMS A LIEN ON ALL OF SAID CORD WOOD NOW OWNED BY THE SAID C. G. FOSTER, OF SAID COUNTY, TO SECURE PAYMENT FOR WORK AND LABOR PERFORMED, AS COOK IN THE WOOD CUTTING CAMP IN THE SECURING OF SAID CORD WOOD LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, THAT W. E. SEELEY CLAIMS A LIEN UPON A QUANTITY OF CORDWOOD BEING ABOUT 20 CORDS 4 FOOT WOOD AND TWO CORDS 16" WOOD, CUT AND MANUFACTURED IN SKAMANIA COUNTY WASHINGTON, PILED ON THE SIDING ABOUT 600 FEET WEST OF THE STATION AT SKAMANIA, BEING A PILE OF WOOD COMMENCING AT THE COUNTY ROAD CROSSING AND LYING FROM THENCE EASTERLY; FOR LABOR PERFORMED IN HAULING THE SAID WOOD RENDERED IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNERS OF SAID WOOD ARE HARRY RIEF AND RAY PIPER, AND THAT THEY EMPLOYED THIS CLAIMANT TO PERFORM SAID WORK AND LABOR FOR THE PRICE OF \$1.00 PER CORD FOR 4 FOOT WOOD, AND \$1.25 PER CORD FOR SHORT WOOD.

THAT SAID HARRY RIEF AND RAY PIPER AGREED TO PAY FOR THE SAID LABOR THE SUM OF \$22.50; THAT THE CONTRACT HAS BEEN FAITHFULLY PERFORMED ON THE PART OF THE CLAIMANT AND SUCH LABOR WAS PERFORMED BETWEEN THE 12TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1921 AND THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1921, AND SAID SERVICES AND LABOR WAS CLOSED ON THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1921 AND THIRTY DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THE COMPLETION THEREOF.
