Notice of Location of Quartz Claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years, on the first day of August 1899 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead within the limits of the claim hereby located and have this 1st day of August 1899 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States located fifteen hundred linear feet of this the Right Half Lode in length with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the centre of said lode situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the Buck Mining Claim.

Beginning at the East end of the Buck Mining Claim Right Half Lode, and running thence 1500 feet in an Easterly direction

And that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, customs and rules of miners and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
