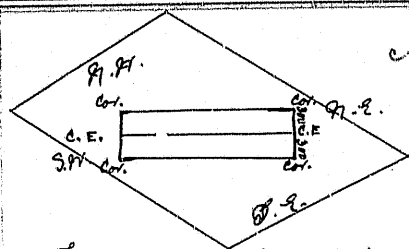


Quartz claim on Sixteen to one Lode. Bald Mountain Mining District.

Bald Mountain Mining District.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six, of Title thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District have located and do hereby locate fifteen hundred linear feet on the Sixteen to one Lode situated in Skamania County, in above State and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked N.E. corner post at the North East corner, from thence 300 feet in a South Westerly direction to a center end post marked South end post, thence 300 feet in South Westerly direction to a corner post marked S. East post, thence 1000 feet in a North Westerly direction to a corner post, marked South West, thence 300 feet in a North Easterly direction to a center end post marked North End Post, thence 300 feet in a North Easterly direction to a corner post marked North West cor Post, thence 1000 feet to place of beginning, intending to claim 1500 linear feet in length and 300 linear feet in width, for the purpose of mining the same, claiming all surface rights, privileges and minerals, and other right granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described as follows:

The North East corner post is located 40 rods South West of the quarter stake of the East line of Sec. 13. Twp. 3. North range 5 East R. M. and the North End connects with the South End of the Gold Standard Claim

Posts are placed at each corner and both ends of center line. This notice is placed at discovery.
