

Proof of Labor on "Blue Jacket" Mining Claim, Bald Mountain Mining District

C. L. Canby, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says, that at least Three Hundred Dollars' worth of labor or improvements were performed or made upon the Blue Jacket mining claim, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania, State of Washington during the year ending December 31st, 1898, said improvement consisting of a tunnel run in said mine for a distance of 40 feet; and deponent further says on oath, that at least Four Hundred Dollars worth of labor or improvements were performed or made upon said mine during the year ending Dec. 31st, 1899, said improvements consisting in a shaft sunk to the depth of Fifty feet; such expenditure was made at the expense of C. L. Canby and L. M. Haddon, owners of said claim, for the purpose of holding said claim.
