

"Copper Bottom" claim, Bald Mountain Mining District.

Notice of Location of Quartz claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the first day of August 1899, discovered a vein or lode of quartz or sand rock in place, bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 30 day of August 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of the vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated on the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington, and known as the Copper Bottom Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery of prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows: To wit:

Situated about 400 ft. S.W. from box house 12 x 18 ft. also about 1,500 ft. N.E. of sec. corner of 5. This claim commencing at discovery shaft running 500 ft. N. Westerly to center end stake, also commencing at shaft and running S. Easterly 1,000 ft. to center end stake and 300 ft. each side of center. Situated on S. 8. 1/4 of T. 5. R. 5 E. of T. M. and that I bind to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
