To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
 Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land
 Office of the United States a Certificate numbered two hundred
 and ninety-one of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver
 Washington Territory whereby it appears that under the
 provisions of the act of Congress approved the 27th day of
 Sept 1860 entitled an act to create the Office of Surveyor
 General of the Public Lands in Oregon and to provide for
 the Survey and to make Donations to Settlers of the said
 Public Lands and the Legislation supplemental thereto
 the Claim of James M Findly of Skamania County
 Washington Territory No 487 has been established
 to a donation of one half section or three hundred and twenty
 acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and
 designated as Claim number thirty seven being a part of
 Section thirty one in Township Three North of Range nine
 East and Claim number thirty nine being a part of Section
 Thirty six in Township Three North of Range eight east according
 to the Official Plat of Survey returned to the General Land
 Office of the Surveyor General Being bounded and described
 as follows to wit Beginning at a point forty six chains
 and fifty links north and twenty seven chains and fifty
 links east of the point where the Township line between
 Township Three North of Range eight east and three North
 of Range Nine East strikes the Columbia River and running
 thence west eighty chains thence south thirty five chains
 and twenty five links thence south sixty four degrees and
 forty five minutes east twenty two chains and eighty
 links thence south seventy nine degrees east ten chains
 and forty links thence east three chains and fifty links
 thence north eighty eight degrees and thirty minutes east
 eighteen chains and twenty links thence north eighty
 one degrees and thirty minutes east ten chains
 and twenty links thence north seventy four degrees east
 eighteen chains and thirteen links and thence north
 forty chains to the place of beginning in the districts of
 lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory
 containing three hundred and fifty one acres and twenty one
