

"Golden Eagle" Claim, Quartz Creek Mining District

To whom it may concern;

Notice is hereby given, that I the undersigned a citizen of the United States of America, conforming with the mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington, and the local rules and regulations and customs of miners, having located and by this notice do locate claim known as the "Golden Eagle" lode or mining claim, said claim being discovered the 29 day of August 1899, and do claim 600 x 1500 ^{hundred} feet on this lead, lode or vein, bearing mineral in place by 600 hundred feet in width, the same being 1500 ft - 300 ft feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs, and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, situated in Quartz Creek mining district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being discovered and marked on the ground as follows, to wit:

commencing at discovery stake thence 300 ft North Easterly corner stake thence 1500 ft to South Easterly corner stake thence 300 ft South Southerly center stake thence 300 ft South Westerly corner stake thence 1500 ft North Westerly corner stake thence 300 ft Northerly center stake Place of discovery. And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs, and rules of miners and mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, Skamania County.
