

"Copper King" Claim. Copper Creek Mining District.

Notice of Location

To whom it may concern:

Notice is herby given, that J. A. Collett and L. J. Lebecki
citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-
one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six
of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States,
and of all other mining laws hereof, and of the State of Wash-
ington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of
miners, did on the 15th day of September A.D. 1899, locate,
and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known
as the Copper King Lode or Mining Claim, said claim
having been discovered the 6th day of August 1899, and do claim
(fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing min-
eral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being
three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with
all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top
or apex of which lie within said boundaries) twenty acres min-
ing ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of
Okanogan State of Washington said location being described
and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or perman-
ent monuments, and more particularly described as follows.
To wit:

Beginning at this discovery and notice on Canyon Creek it runs 300 feet in an easterly direction to the Center end stake thence 300 feet in a northerly direction to the North East corner stake thence 1500 feet in a Westerly direction to the North West corner stake thence 300 feet in a Southerly direction to the Center end stake thence 300 feet in a Southerly direction to the South West corner stake thence 1500 feet in an Easterly direction to the South East corner stake thence 300 feet Northerly to the Center end stake thence 300 feet on center line back to discovery and notice thence (1200) twelve hundred feet Westerly on center line to the Center end stake this discovery and notice is about 600 feet below the mouth of Copper Creek on the East side of the main stream of Canyon Creek

and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance
with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws
of the United States and of the State of Washington.
