NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, THAT PAUL COCHRAN, OF WILLARD, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CLAIMS A LIEN UPON A QUANTITY OF SAW LOGS, BEING ABOUT 50,000 FEET, NOW IN THE BOOM ROBERT SNODGRASS, AT COOK, WASHINGTON, MARKED X ON END OF LOG. ALSO A QUANTITY OF SAW LOGS NOW IN THE WOODS, BEING APPROXIMATELY 50,000 FEET, NEAR THE WILLARD ROAD, ABOUT 1 1/4 MILES SOUTH OF THE WILLARD POST OFFICE, MARKED X ON THE END OF LOG. FOR LABOR PERFORMED UPON AND ASSISTANCE RENDERED IN THE MANUFACTURE OF SAID LOGS; THAT THE OWNERS OR REPUTED OWNERS OF THE SAID SAW-LOGS ARE HARRY DUNLAP, EARNEST DUNLAP AND HERMAN FIELDS, DOING BUSINESS AS DUNLAP AND FIELDS; THAT THE SAID DUNLAP AND FIELDS EMPLOYED CLAIMANT TO PERFORM SAID WORK AND LABOR UPON THE AGREED WAGE OF \$4.00 PER DAY OF EIGHT HOURS, OR \$.50 PER HOUR; THAT CLAIMANT HAS FAITHFULLY PERFORMED SAID WORK AND LABOR, AND SAID CONTRACT HAS BEEN FULLY PERFORMED BY CLAIMANT WHO PERFORMED SAID LABOR FOR A PERIOD OF 190 DAYS AND 4 HOURS; THAT SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WAS SO RENDERED BETWEEN THE 16TH DAY OF JUNE 1924 AND THE 17TH DAY OF JULY 1924, AND SAID SERVICES AND LABOR WERE CLOSED ON THE SAID 17TH DAY OF JULY 1924, AND 30 DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THAT TIME; THAT THE AMOUNT OF CLAIMANTS DEMAND FOR SAID SERVICES IS \$78.00, AND THAT NO PART THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID, AND THERE IS NOW DUE AND OWING THE CLAIMANT FROM SAID OWNERS THE SAID SUM OF \$78.00 IN WHICH AMOUNT HE CLAIMS A LIEN UPON SAID SAW-LOGS.

THAT THE SAID PAUL COCHRAN ALSO CLAIMS A LIEN UPON ALL OF SAID SAW-LOGS OWNED BY THE SAID DUNLAP AND FIELDS WITHIN SKAMANIA COUNTY WASHINGTON FOR THE WORK IN SECURING THE SAID SAW LOGS HEREIN DESCRIBED AND ALSO CLAIMS A LIEN UPON THE PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING HORSES, LOGGING EQUIPMENT, TOOLS AND MACHINERY, AND UPON ALL REAL PROPERTY, FRANCHISES, AND EARNINGS BELONGING TO THE SAID HARRY DUNLAP, EARNEST DUNLAP AND HERMAN FIELDS USED IN THE OPERATION OF THEIR BUSINESS IN LOGGING AT WILLARD, WASHINGTON, TO THE EXTENT OF THE MONEYS DUE SAID CLAIMANT FOR THE WORK AND SERVICES ABOVE MENTIONED.
