

# "Iron Cap" Claim, Bald Mountain Mining District

Know all Men by these Presents, that I the undersigned, have this 1st day of September 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 600 feet width on the line along the lode thereof, 1500 feet of said claim, lying and being North Westerly of the discovery, with all dips, spurs, variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:

Situated on the Silver Creek in the Bald Mountain Mining District and known as the Iron Cap Mining Claim. The exterior boundaries of this claim is as follows: Beginning at prospect running 300 ft S. Westerly to S. W. Corner Post. Thence 1500 ft N. Westerly to N. W. Corner Post. Thence 300 ft N. Easterly to North Center end Post. Thence 300 ft same direction to N. E. Corner Post. Thence 1500 ft S. Easterly to S. E. Corner Post. Thence 300 ft S. Westerly to place of beginning.

The adjoining claims are the Skylark on the East. Lyon on the West and Condor on the South. Boundaries marked by posts planted at the corners and center side points.
