

Notice of Location of "Quarry" Mining Claim

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six, of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and its local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 9th month day of June A.D. 1898 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Quarry Claim, known as the Quarry lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 9th month day of June 1898 and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet in this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Jackson Mountain Community of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice and running two hundred linear feet southerly to center end stake thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a northerly direction to center end stake thence three hundred linear feet along the Copper King mine to South east Corner stake thence fifteen hundred feet in a northerly direction to North east Corner stake thence three hundred linear feet to center to center end stake thence three hundred linear feet to North west Corner stake thence fifteen hundred feet to South West Corner stake thence three hundred linear feet along the Copper King mine to center end stake back to place of beginning.

Situated in Jackson Mountain Mining District and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
