

"Billy Mc Kinley" claim, Bald Mountain Mining District

Notice of Location of Quartz claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 31 day of Aug. 1899, discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 14 day of September 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated on the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania, and State of Washington and known as the Billy Mc Kinley Mining claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the superior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Claim 1 mile south of Skamania Cabin, claim running west 300 ft from lode post. Thence 1500 ft. from north west corner post to south west corner post. Thence 600 ft from south west corner post to south east corner post. Thence 1500 ft. from south east corner post to north east corner post. Thence 300 ft west from north east corner post to lode post, viz:

and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
