The U. S. to Clinton S. Cranson

The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come
Greeting:

Whereas Clinton S. Cranson of Pierce County Washington Territory, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Clinton S. Cranson, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North East quarter of Section Eighteen in Township (2) two North, of Range Six East, of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Clinton S. Cranson.
