United States to James E. Page

The United States of America
To all to whom these presents shall come
Greeting:

Whereas James E. Page, of Pierce County
Washington Territory, has deposited in the
General Land Office of the United States a
certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby
it appears that full payment has been
made by the said James E. Page, according to
the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th
of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making
further provision for the sale of the Public
Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for
the North West quarter of Section twelve (12)
in Township Two (2) North of Range six (6)
East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington
Territory, containing one hundred and sixty
(160) Acres, according to the official Plat of
the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the
General Land Office by the Surveyor General,
which Tract has been purchased by the said
James E. Page.

Now know Ye, That the United States of
America, in consideration of the premises,
and in conformity with the several Acts of
Congress in such case made and pro-
vided, have given and granted, and by
these presents do give and grant unto the
