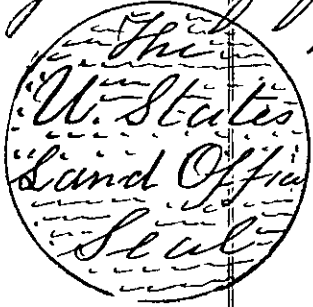

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas, Joseph H. Buckingham of Whatcom County, Washington Territory, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph H. Buckingham according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands;" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North West quarter of Section twenty-six (26) in Township three (3) North of Range six (6) East of Wabamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to
