Witnesseth: That Isaac Thomas Mary Dryman, Edmon Thomas and Henry Thomas of Shumania County, Wash. parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, money of the United States of America to us in hand paid by William Butler of Shumania County, Washington, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all of the following described real Estate, situated in Shumania County, Washington, to wit:

The West half of what is known as the Dryman Land. The same being a part of that piece or parcel of land divided and conveyed by H. A. & Phema Leavans, husband and wife to John Dryman, deceased, on the 8th day of April A.D. 1878, and situated in Section Thirty-five (35) Township two (2) North of Range Six (6) East, and containing ten ($10\frac{3}{4}$) Thirty one hundredths acres.
