REED, OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CLAIMS A LIEN UPON 200,000 FEET OF SAW LOGS WITHOUT BRAND OR MARK WHICH WERE CUT IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON AND ARE NOW LYING IN THE TIMBER ABOUT ONE-HALF MILE SOUTHEAST OF THE MILL OF THE CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY, LOCATED ON BEAR CREEK, ABOUT SIX MILES NORTHEAST OF CARSON, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FOR LABOR PERFORMED UPON AND ASSISTANCE RENDERED IN CUTTING SAID LOGS; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNER OR REPUTED OWNER IS CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY; THAT SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY EMPLOYED CLAIMANT TO PERFORM SUCH LABOR AND RENDER ASSISTANCE UPON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS, TO-WIT: THAT SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AGREED TO PAY CLAIMANT FOR SUCH LABOR AND ASSISTANCE THE SUM OF 50¢ AN HOUR; THAT THE LABOR PERFORMED WAS THAT OF SWAMPING IN THE LOGGING CAMP OF SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY; THAT SAID CONTRACT HAS BEEN FAITHFULLY PERFORMED AND FULLY COMPLIED WITH ON THE PART OF SAID CLAIMANT WHO PERFORMED LABOR UPON AND ASSISTED IN CUTTING SAID LOGS FOR THE PERIOD OF FORTY-EIGHT HOURS; THAT SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WAS SO PERFORMED AND RENDERED UPON SAID LOGS BETWEEN THE 7TH DAY OF JULY, 1925 AND THE 14TH DAY OF JULY, 1925 AND THE RENDITION OF SAID SERVICES WAS CEASED ON THE 14TH DAY OF JULY, 1925, AND THIRTY DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THAT TIME; THAT THE AMOUNT OF CLAIMANT'S DEMAND FOR SAID SERVICE IS \$17.20; THAT NO PART THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID AND THERE IS NOW DUE AND REMAINING UNPAID THEREON AFTER

FOSS, OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CLAIMS A LIEN UPON 200,000 FEET OF SAW LOGS WITHOUT BRAND OR MARK WHICH WERE CUT IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON AND ARE NOW LYING IN THE TIMBER ABOUT ONE-HALF MILE SOUTHEAST OF THE MILL OF THE CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY, LOCATED ON BEAR CREEK, ABOUT SIX MILES NORTHEAST OF CARSON, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FOR LABOR PERFORMED UPON AND ASSISTANCE RENDERED IN CUTTING SAID LOGS; THAT THE NAME OF THE OWNER OR REPUTED OWNER IS CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY; THAT SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY EMPLOYED CLAIMANT TO PERFORM SUCH LABOR AND RENDER ASSISTANCE UPON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS, TO-WIT: THAT SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AGREED TO PAY CLAIMANT FOR SUCH LABOR AND ASSISTANCE THE SUM OF \$4.00 PER DAY; THAT THE LABOR PERFORMED WAS THAT OF YARD MAN IN THE LOGGING CAMP OF SAID CARSON MILL & FLUME COMPANY AND C. C. SHAY; THAT SAID CONTRACT HAS BEEN FAITHFULLY PERFORMED AND FULLY COMPLIED WITH ON THE PART OF SAID CLAIMANT WHO PERFORMED LABOR UPON AND ASSISTANCE IN CUTTING SAID LOGS FOR THE PERIOD OF 308 HOURS; THAT SAID LABOR AND ASSISTANCE WAS SO PERFORMED AND RENDERED UPON SAID LOGS BETWEEN THE 1ST DAY OF JUNE, 1925 AND THE 15TH DAY OF JULY, 1925 AND THE RE rendition OF SAID SERVICES CEASED ON THE 15TH DAY OF JULY, 1925, AND THIRTY DAYS HAVE NOT ELAPSED SINCE THAT TIME; THAT THE AMOUNT OF CLAIMANT'S DEMAND FOR SAID LOGS IS \$128.07, ABOVE ALL CREDITS; THAT
