

Location Notice "Leib" Mining Claim.

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, That we the undersigned Citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws and regulations of miners, did, on the 9 day of June A.D. 1898, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the Leib Lode or Mining Claim said claim having been discovered the 9 day of June 1898 and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or leads, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, situated in Larkspur Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and running seven hundred linear feet to center and stake placed thence ^{one} hundred linear feet East to center and stake thence three hundred linear feet along the Denny mine to North East corner stake thence fifteen hundred linear feet in to North West corner stake thence three hundred linear feet to center and stake, thence three hundred linear feet to South West corner thence fifteen hundred linear feet to South east corner stake thence three hundred linear feet along the Denny mine to center and stake to place of beginning.

Situated in Larkspur Mining District, and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and laws of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
