This Indenture made and entered into this 4th day of June A.D. 1886 by and between James C. Marr and Benjamin F. Marr both of Clay County Missouri half brothers of the late Kingz Marr deceased of Hannibal County Washington Territory parties of the first part and Lewis Marr of said Hannibal County Washington Territory party of the second part Witnesses that the parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold assigned transferred and set over and have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto him the said party of the second part all our right title and interest as heirs at law of the late Kingz Marr deceased aforesaid and of others of in or to all and singular the real and personal property and the estate and effects of every kind and nature in said Territory of Washington owned by and belonging to him the said Kingz Marr deceased at the time of his death or in which his estate has since his said death acquired any interest or title whatsoever together with all and singular the rights privileges appurtenances and hereditaments thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to us as such heirs at law and otherwise of the said Kingz Marr deceased and to all the estate and property aforesaid us fully to all intents and purposes as though he the said party of the second part were the sole heir at law of the said Kingz Marr deceased To have and to hold to him the said party of the second part his heirs assigns forever In witness whereof the said parties of the first part have hereunto signed their names and affixed their seals the date first above written
