The United States of America, to Peter O. Aye
To all to whom these presents shall come: Greeting.
Whereas, Peter O. Aye, of Multnomah County
Oregon has deposited in the General Land
Office of the United States, a certificate of the
Register of the Land Office at Vancouver
Washington Territory, whereby it appears that
full payment has been made by Peter O.
Aye, according to the provisions of the Act
of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled
"An Act making further provision for the sale
of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental
thereto, for the South West quarter of Section eight
in Township three North of Range six East
of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory,
containing one hundred and sixty acres, ac-
cording to the Official Plat of Survey of the
said Lands, returned to the General Land
Office by the Surveyor General, which said
Tract has been purchased by the said Peter
O. Aye.

Now know Ye, That the United States
of America in consideration of the premises,
and in conformity to the several Acts of Con-
gress in such case made and provided,
have granted and given, and by these pres-
ents do grant and give, unto the said
Peter O. Aye, and to his heirs, the Tract
above described: To have and to hold
the same together with all the rights, priv-
ileges, immunities, and appurtenances,
of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging,
unto the said Peter O. Aye, and to his heirs
and assigns forever; subject to any vested
right of accrued water rights for mining,
agricultural, manufacturing, or other pur-
poses, and rights to ditches and reservoirs
used in connection with such water rights,
as may be recognized and acknowledged
by the local customs, laws, and decisions of
courts, and also subject to the right of the
