The United States to John R. Atwood.

The United States of America,
To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, John R. Atwood of Multnomah County, Oregon, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John R. Atwood, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said John R. Atwood.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America in consideration of the promises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John R. Atwood and to his heirs, the said Tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said John R. Atwood and to his heirs and assigns forever.

Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing or other purposes, and
