Certificate The United States of America to C. P. Bryant
 No. 3396 To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:
 Whereas Charles P. Bryant of Multnomah
 County, Oregon has deposited in the General
 Land Office of the United States a certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver
 Washington Territory, whereby it appears that
 full payment has been made by the said
 Charles P. Bryant, according to the provisions
 of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820,
 entitled "An Act making further provision for
 the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts
 supplemental thereto, for the North East
 quarter of Section eighteen in Township
 thirty North of Range six East of Willamette
 Meridian in Washington Territory, contain-
 ing one hundred and sixty acres,
 according to the official Plat of Survey
 of said Lands, returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General, which
 Tract has been purchased by the said
 Charles P. Bryant.

Now I know Ye. That the United States of
 America in consideration of the premises,
 and in conformity with the several Acts of
 Congress in such case made and provi-
 ded, have given and granted, and by these
 presents do give and grant unto the said
 Charles P. Bryant, and to his heirs, the said
