The United States to Levy Leon.
The United States of America do,
To all to whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting.
Whereas, Levy Leon of Multnomah County, Oregon
has deposited in the General Land Office of the
United States, a Certificate of the Register of the
Land Office at Vancouver, Washington
Territory, whereby it appears that full
payment has been made by the said Levy
Leon, according to the provisions of the Act of
Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled
"An Act making further provision for the sale
of the Public Lands," and the acts sup-
plemental thereto, for the North West quarter
of Section Twenty-eight, in Township three
North of Range Six East of Willamette
Meridian in Washington Territory, contain-
ing one hundred and sixty acres according
to the official Plat of the Survey of the said
Lands, returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General, which said Tract
has been purchased by the said Levy Leon.
