To all to whom these presents shall come. Greeting
Whereas Theodore Bernheim of Multnomah County, Oregon has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Theodore Bernheim according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplementary thereto, for the South East quarter of Section Twenty-Eight, in Township three North of Range Six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Theodore Bernheim.
