The United States of America,
To all to whom these presents shall come. Greeting:
Whereas, William M. Robinson of Mult-
nomah County, Oregon has deposited in
the General Land Office of the United States,
a certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby
it appears that full payment has been
made by the said William M. Robinson,
according to the provisions of the Act of Con-
gress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled
"An Act making further provision for the
sale of the Public Lands," and the acts suppl-
emental thereto, for the lots numbered one
and two, and the East half of the North
West quarter of Section Eighteen in Town-
ship Three North of Range Six East of Wal-
lacet Meridian, in Washington Territory,
containing one hundred and fifty acres
and eighty hundredths of an acre, accord-
ing to the Official Plat of the Survey of the
said Lands, returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General, which Tract has been
purchased by the said William M. Robinson.
Now Know Ye, That the United States of
America, in consideration of the premises,
and in conformity with the several Acts
of Congress in such case made and
provided, have given and granted, and
by these presents do give and grant unto the
said William M. Robinson, and to his heirs,
the said Tract above described.

To have and to hold the same together
with all the rights, privileges, immunities
and appurtenances of whatsoever nature be-
longing thereto, unto the said William M.
Robinson, and to his heirs and assigns
forever; subject to any vested and accord
water rights for mining, agricultural, manuf-
facturing, or other purposes, and rights to
