The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Benjamin C. Stanton of Multnomah County Oregon, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Benjamin C. Stanton, according to the provisions of the Act of 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South West quarter of Section Twenty-one in Township three North of Range six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Benjamin C. Stanton.
