Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that I, Grinnell Mordica Jones having declared my intentions of becoming a citizen of the United States over the age of 21 years have this day located under the Revised Statutes of the United States (Chap 6, Title 32) The following described Quartz ground situate in Hamamie County Washington and more particularly described as follows to, wit:

Beginning at Camp Creek on S. A. Rich's place claim, commencing near the S. W. corner and running Northerly 1500 feet Thence Easterly 300 feet to center stake Thence Southerly 1500 ft, Thence Westerly 300 feet to center stake, Thence Westerly 300 ft to place of beginning together with all water rights appertaining to said land.

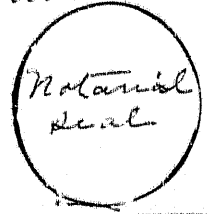
