

"Jeffries" Mining Claim. Bald Mountain District.

Notice of amended location of Quartz mining Claim.

Notice is hereby given that I, W. A. Howe, a citizen of the United States, having complied with the requirements of the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws and regulations, have located, and claim by virtue of the original discovery and location and this amended certificate of location, fifteen hundred feet on this the Lawton lode of mineral bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto. This claim is situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington, and is and shall be known as the Lawton lode of mineral bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto. This claim is situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington, and is and shall be known as the Jeffries mining Claim.

The general course of said lode is North  $59^{\circ}52'$  West and I claim in length on said lode fifteen hundred feet Northwesterly from the point of discovery, at which point I have posted an original duplicate of this notice. I have marked the surface boundaries of this claim by placing substantial posts not less than three feet high and four inches in diameter at each corner of said claim, clearing the name of the lode and of the claim and the date of location, and have cut the brush and marked and blazed the trees along the lines of said claim to indicate the location of said lines.

The surface boundary of this claim is particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a post on a mound of rock at the South east corner of said claim (being also the corner of the Spruce claim) said post being 2173 feet East and 1510 feet East of the Northwest corner of Section 28 in Township 3 North of Range 5 East of the Willamette meridian and running thence North  $59^{\circ}52'$  West fifteen hundred feet;

thence North  $32^{\circ}$  East six hundred feet, thence South  $59^{\circ}$   
 $52'$  East fifteen hundred (1500) feet; thence South  $32^{\circ}$  West  
six hundred (600) feet to the place of beginning.  
And I intend to hold and work said above described claim  
as provided by the laws of the United States and of the State  
of Washington.

This is an amended location of the Jeffries claim, dis-  
covered by A. J. Lawton on the 19th day of June 1899, and  
located on the 20th day of June 1899, and recorded at page  
165 of Book "D" of Miscellaneous Records of Skamania Coun-  
ty, Washington, I now being the owner of said claim by  
purchase and conveyance from said original locator.

This amended certificate of location is made without  
waiver of any rights previously acquired by me by virtue  
of said original location, purchase and conveyance,  
and for the purpose of correcting any errors in the origi-  
nal location, description or record of said claim, and of  
taking in any additional ground which is subject to location,  
and any part of any overlapping claim which has been aban-  
doned.
