

Notice of Water Right on Washougal River

Notice of Water Right

The undersigned, a citizen of the United States, hereby gives notice as follows, to wit;

First: That he claims (and appropriates) the water lying, being and flowing in the East Fork of the North Fork of the Washougal River to the extent of Five Hundred cubic feet per second of time.

Second: That said water is appropriated for mining, milling, power and domestic purposes, and the place of its intended use is at either or all of the following named mining claims and mill sites, to wit; "Spruce" and "Shell Rock" Claims on the "Yellow Jack" Lode, "Little Nell" and "Omnia Bona Bonis" claims on the "Hoo Hoo" Lode, "C & S" and "Advance" claims on "Shell Rock Lode," "Spruce" and "Granite" claims on Okanogan Lode "16 to 1" "Powers" "Fudge" and "Skye" claims on Last Chance Lode, and the Last Chance, mill site, all being situated and located in Township Three (3) North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian in the Bald Mountain Mining District, in the County of Okanogan, State of Washington.

Third: The means by which it is intended to divert said water from the natural channel of said stream is by ditch, ditches, flume, flumes or pipes (or by ditches, flumes & pipes) beginning at a point where this notice is posted, on the bank or side of said stream about thirty feet above the dam now constructed across said stream said water to be conveyed in the manner aforesaid from said point where this notice is posted on the nearest and most practicable way or route or ways and routes to said intended place and places of use.
