

and twenty seven (27) links West of the North East Corner of Section Twenty-five (25) in Township Two (2) North, Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence East-Northeast-South (77) chains; thence South  $22^{\circ}$  East Eleven (11) chains and forty (40) links to the north fork of Hamilton Creek or Slough; thence along the North bank of said Creek or Slough down stream to and along the North bank of the Columbia River to a point due South of the place of beginning; thence North to the place of beginning. Containing  $319 \frac{78}{100}$  acres, situated in Shumana County, Wash.

if the sums of money due upon said note be paid according to the agreements therein expressed, this conveyance shall be void; but in case default is made in the payment of the principal or interest as therein provided, then the said Louis Sohns or his legal representatives may sell the premises above described, with all the appurtenances thereto, or any part thereof, in the manner provided by law, and out of the money arising from such sale, retain the said principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any, there be, pay over to the said William J. Hamilton, his heirs and assigns.
