

Blanche W. Geomans to H. W. Festerwife

This Indenture, made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September A.D. 1891, between Blanche W. Geomans, of Su. Geomans, Clarke Co. Wash. the party of the first part, and Henry W. Fester, and V. V. Fester of Skamania County, State of Washington the parties of the second part.

Whereas, said parties of the second part, by Indenture of Mortgage, bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1891, and recorded in the Office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington in Volume B. of Mortgages, on page 290, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1891, did for the consideration and purposes therein set forth, Mortgage the premises therein described.

Now, therefore, this Indenture witnesseth, that the said Blanche W. Geomans party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one dollar paid to the said party of the first part, by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents release and discharge from the lien of said Mortgage, and from all effects thereof, all that part of the said mortgaged lands, bounded and described, as follows, to wit:

Commencing at the stake corner to Sections 17, 18, 19, & 20 of Township 1 N. R. 5 E. of the Willamette Meridian, running thence North ten chains (10 ch.) Thence West ten chains (10 ch.) Thence South ten chains (10 ch.) Thence East ten chains (10 ch.) to the place of beginning.

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
