

Tenderfoot Mining Claim in Copper Creek District

Notice of Location of Quartz Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 6 day of Sept 1899, discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 12 day of Sept 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the Tenderfoot Mining claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Situated about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of Texas Gulch on the right fork of Maiden Gulch about 250 ft from the junction of its two forks, also about 300 ft above the falls on Maiden Gulch & is joined on the N.E. end of the Christmas Tree, also about 700 ft east of the shaft of the North Pacific, said claim is in Sec 25, Township 4 North of range 5 East Beginning at the S.W. corner & running 600ft S.E. to S.E. corner, thence 1500 ft North of N.E. to N.E. corner thence 600ft N.W. to N.W. corner. thence 1500 ft South of S.W. to S.W. corner. Said claim extend 1450 ft North of S.E. & 50 ft South of S.W. from shaft & notice, and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
