PEARSON, FOREMAN AND AGENT OF SAID WESTERN SPAR COMPANY THE ABOVE NAMED CLAIMANT COMMENCED TO PERFORM LABOR IN THE OPERATION OF THE BUSINESS OF SAID WESTERN SPAR COMPANY, A CORPORATION, LOCATED AND DOING BUSINESS AT AND NEAR GREENLEAF, SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND OPERATING OVER THE LOGGING RAILROAD KNOWN AS THE GREENLEAF LUMBER COMPANY ROAD, AND THE TRACK EXTENSION OF THE WESTERN SPAR COMPANY, IN SAID SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, OF WHICH TRACK EXTENSION THE SAID WESTERN SPAR COMPANY WAS AND IS THE OWNER OR REPUTED OWNER.
