I, the undersigned witnesseth that we Henry Furth and Helen Furth his wife of Skamania County Wash. in consideration of one hundred (100) dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto Elizabeth Fletcher of Washington D.C. the following described Premises to wit the South West quarter of Section two (2) in Township One (1) North of Range five (5) east of the Willamette meridian containing one hundred and sixty acres and situate in the County of Skamania Washington Territory together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Elizabeth Fletcher her heirs and assigns for ever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the Payment of the sum of one hundred ⁽¹⁰⁰⁾ dollars and the interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain Promissory note of which the following is a copy to wit

Two years after date for value received I Promise to the Order of Elizabeth Fletcher one hundred (100) dollars with interest thereon Payable annually at the rate of ten (10) Per cent Per annum from date if the same is not Paid when due is shall be compounded with the Principal and Bear like interest therewith Principal and interest Payable in U.S. Gold Coin and in case Suit is instituted to Collect this note
