NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON OR ABOUT THE 5TH DAY OF JULY, 1926, THE WALLACE BRIDGE & STRUCTURAL STEEL COMPANY, A CORPORATION, AT THE REQUEST OF THE UNION BRIDGE COMPANY AND PUGET SOUND BRIDGE & DREDGING COMPANY, WHICH CORPORATIONS WERE DULY AUTHORIZED AGENTS OF THE WAUNA TOLL BRIDGE COMPANY UNDER CONTRACT TO CONSTRUCT A BRIDGE ACROSS THE COLUMBIA RIVER, COMMENCED TO PERFORM LABOR AND FURNISH MATERIAL TO BE USED, AND WHICH WAS USED UPON THAT CERTAIN BRIDGE OVER THE COLUMBIA RIVER FROM THE COLUMBIA HIGHWAY TO THE NORTH BANK HIGHWAY, BEING THAT CERTAIN TOLL BRIDGE WITH A STEEL SUPERSTRUCTURE, AND GENERALLY KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS THE "BRIDGE OF THE GODS", AND BEGINNING:

AT A POINT ON THE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS TWELVE (12) AND THIRTEEN (13) IN TOWNSHIP TWO (2), NORTH OF RANGE SEVEN (7), EAST OF VILLAGETTE MERIDIAN, IN HOOD

RIVER COUNTY OREGON, 4285.6 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION TWELVE (12), SAID TOWNSHIP AND RANGE; THENCE EXTENDING IN A STRAIGHT LINE BEARING NORTH SEVENTY SIX DEGREES, FORTY FOUR MINUTES, WEST, ACROSS THE COLUMBIA RIVER, AND TO AND ACROSS THE MAIN TRACK OF THE SPOKANE, PORTLAND & SEATTLE RAILWAY COMPANY, IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON,
