Interest payable semi-annually, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. If not so collected, the interest to be added to and become part of the principal, and the same to bear interest thereafter, until paid, at the rate of twelve per cent per annum. And in case action is commenced to enforce payment of this note, or any portion thereof, we jointly and severally promise to pay such additional sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees in such action.
